For a serene finale, either board a van or opt for a scenic ride along the Chao Phraya River on a solar boat or traditional long-tail boat to Poomjai Garden. Here, you'll enjoy a delightful lunch and embark on a peaceful garden tour, exploring the diverse flora and fauna of this hidden oasis.

End the day with a Thai dessert workshop, where you'll learn the art of creating traditional sweets like Khanom Bua Loi or Khanom Sai Sai.
