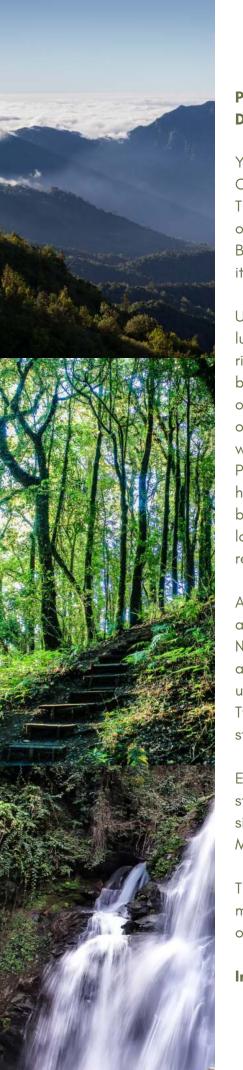

Your adventure begins at 08:00 AM with a scenic drive from your hotel in Chiang Mai to the breathtaking Doi Inthanon National Park, home to Thailand's highest peak. Along the way, you'll stop at a local market that offers a taste of authentic Thai life, far from the usual tourist spots. Browse the vibrant stalls, filled with fresh produce, snacks, and household items, and pick up some local fruits or treats for the day ahead.

Upon arrival at Doi Inthanon National Park, you'll be greeted by the park's lush landscapes, cool mountain air, and towering forests. Known for its rich biodiversity, Doi Inthanon is a haven for nature lovers. Choose between two trekking options, depending on your preference and the time of year. The Kew Mae Pan Nature Trail, available from November to May, offers a slightly more challenging trek with panoramic views and cooler weather, especially between December and February. Alternatively, the Pha Dok Sieo Nature Trail, available year-round, provides a more leisurely hike and includes a stop at a stunning waterfall—perfect for a relaxing break in nature. Both trails are led by knowledgeable guides from the local Karen community, who will share fascinating insights about the region's ecology and their traditional way of life.

After your trek, treat yourself to a cup of locally grown, organic coffee at a nearby coffee shop—a delicious reward for your morning of exploration. Next, visit the peak of Doi Inthanon, standing at 2,565 meters (8,415 feet) above sea level. The cool air and breathtaking views make this stop an unforgettable experience. You'll also have the chance to admire the Royal Twin Pagodas, surrounded by beautifully manicured gardens and offering stunning vistas of the surrounding mountains.

Enjoy a delicious lunch at a local restaurant before heading to the final stop of the day: the impressive Wachiratan Waterfall. Take in the majestic sight of the waterfall's powerful cascade before heading back to Chiang Mai, where you'll arrive at your hotel around 4:00 PM.

This day trip offers an incredible mix of nature, culture, and adventure, making it the perfect escape for those looking to experience the beauty of Thailand's northern highlands.
